

*Representatives of drug user groups across Europe met together with Camurus in Copenhagen in May 2019 to discuss research and innovation in opioid dependence therapy and the need to ensure that new medications are implemented in a manner that supports active and informed decision making.*

*As the first step in a partnership project looking at the treatment rights and literacy for people dependent on opioids, the partners in the Copenhagen consultation agreed the following Position Statement:*

**People who are dependent on opioids have the right to the highest attainable standard of health. This includes access to, information about and the freedom to choose from available opioid dependence pharmacological treatments as well as psycho-social support.**
